I am to state that Jharkhand State Council for Child Welfare(JSCCW) is organizing an "On the Spot Painting Competition" on 15th September 2010 (Wednesday) at 10.15 a.m. at Raj Bhawan Birsa Mandap, Ranchi. This competition is open to school students in the age group of 5-16 years and will be conducted in 3 groups namely;

Green Group	:	Age 5-8 years
White Group	:	Age 9-12 years
Blue Group	:	Age 13-16 years

You are requested to nominate 2 students for each group. The winning entries of each group will be sent to the Indian Council for Child Welfare(ICCW), New Delhi for including them in the National Painting Competition. The rules of the competition are as follows:-

1. The Painting Competition shall be 'ON THE SPOT COMPETITION'.
2. The medium of Painting shall be Pastel, Crayon, Water colour or Oil colour.
3. Time for Painting allowed is two (2) hours only.
4. Competitors must bring all necessary drawing material including drawing board and colours. The drawing paper will be supplied by JSCCW.
5. The decision of the judges will be final. No correspondence, whatsoever shall be entertained.
6. All Paintings submitted for competition shall become the property of the "INDIAN COUNCIL FOR CHILD WELFARE".
7. Five Painting adjudged best in each group will be sent to ICCW for National Level Painting Competition.

The format for sending the entries is enclosed. Kindly submit the same to us latest by 8th September 2010. The recommended students must reach Raj Bhawan Birsa Mandap at 9.30 a.m. on 15th September 2010 (Wednesday). Late comers will not be allowed to participate. Sir/Madam,

I am to state that Jharkhand State Council for Child Welfare(JSCCW) is organizing an "On the Spot Painting Competition" on 15th September 2010(Wednesday) at 10.15 a.m. at Raj Bhavan, Ranchi. This competition is open to Differently abled children in the age group of 5-18 years and will be conducted in 2 groups namely;

Yellow Group : Age 5-10 years

Red Group : Age 11-18 years

Further there will be four sub-groups in each Yellow and Red Groups.

- Spastic/multiple disability
- Mentally challenged
- Visually impaired
- Speech/hearing impaired.

You are requested to nominate 3 students for each group. The winning entries of each group will be sent to the Indian Council for Child

Welfare (ICCW), New Delhi for including them in the National Painting Competition. The rules of the competition are as follows:-

1. The Painting Competition shall be 'ON THE SPOT COMPETITION'.
2. The medium of Painting shall be Pastel, Crayon, Water colour or Oil colour.
3. Time for Painting allowed is two (2) hours only.
4. Competitors must bring all necessary drawing material including drawing board and colours. The drawing paper will be supplied by JSCCW.
5. The decision of the judges will be final. No correspondence, whatsoever shall be entertained.
6. All Paintings submitted for competition shall become the property of the "INDIAN COUNCIL FOR CHILD WELFARE".
7. Specific disability and date of birth of the winners should be indicated on the reverse of the paintings for the above Yellow and Red Sub-Groups.
8. Differently abled Children Means: Visual disability/Hearing disability/Orthopaedic disability or Locomotor disability/ Mentally retarded.
 - (a) Certificate by a Registered Medical Practitioner stating atleast 40% disability of the Competitor must be enclosed for visual disability/ Orthopaedic disability or Locomotor disability.
 - (b) For hearing disability: Minimum 40% decibel disability.
 - (c) Mentally retarded (cut off points I.Q. below 70) is to be certified by a clinical psychologist or psychiatrist.
9. Paintings will be disqualified on the basis of the following:-
 - (a) If the size of the Painting is not according to the scheme.
 - (b) If Subject/Theme does not tally for the group mentioned.
 - (c) Incomplete entries.
 - (d) If age does not tally according to the group.
 - (e) Those in special category not enclosing medical certificate.

The format for sending the entries is enclosed. Kindly submit the same to us latest by ~~8th September 2010~~ ^{8th Sept} 2010. The recommended students must reach Raj Bhavan Birsa Mandap at 9.30 a.m. on 15th September 2010(Wednesday). Late comers will not be allowed to participate.
